Scholarship Distribution

There will be one scholarship, which will be awarded up to \$5,000. The funds will be distributed with \$1,000 of it going to the supporting faculty member and the remainder to the student. Should no qualified application be received during a specific year, no scholarship will be awarded.

Qualifications

The scholarship will be awarded to an undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student undertaking a research project in the field of human factors or human behavior related to fire or emergencies, or to the integration of human factors or human behavior into fire protection engineering. The student may be enrolled in any field of study provided the research relates to people in fire or emergencies. SFPE encourages diversity in applicants and submissions from all geographic regions.

Student Application

The student applicant must submit electronic documentation of the following.

1. Full name of the applicant.
2. Applicant mailing and email addresses.
3. A description of the project (max 1000 words) which illustrates how the research relates to people in fire or emergencies, or to the integration of human factors or human behavior into fire protection engineering. Preference will be given to projects which recognize and are consistent with the SFPE Research Roadmap. The project will be evaluated based on its technical quality, clear methodology and expected outcomes. (60%)
